


### **Preparation before Installation**


- Prior to installation, determine the installation position of the product referring to the following drawings.
- MAJOLICA PORTO Installation Instruction should be throughly read and understood before use.
- Raise the drain pipe, water supply pipe, hot water supply pile referring to MAJOLICA PORTO Installation Instruction and the following plumbing layout.





#### Front View






## **Usage Condition**


#### ■Hot water supply and water supply conditions

Water used	<ul> <li>Public water supply (do not use non-drinkable well water or water that contains rust or sand.)</li> <li>If the water hardness is 80 ppm or higher, install a water softener to prevent the buildup of scale within the basin body. Aeration may be minimal when using shampoo even if drinkable well water is used, so a water softener should be installed.</li> </ul>
Hot water supply, water supply pressure	<ul> <li>•Use a pressure between 0.1 and 0.4MPa(1 - 4kgf/cm<sup>2</sup>).</li> <li>•Set the water supply pressure≥hot water supply pressure.</li> <li>•Set the difference between the hot water supply pressure and water supply pressure to within 0.2MPa(2kgf/cm<sup>2</sup>)</li> </ul>
Hot water temperature into the product	<ul> <li>Set the hot water temperature to 80 °C or less.</li> <li>Set the temperature 10 °C or higher than the shower temperature used.</li> </ul>
Water boiler	•Do not use steam with the hot water supply

# Parts List / Accessory Parts




- 1. Before installation, with reference to "MAJOLICA PORTO Installation instruction", raise the water supply pipes and drainpipe.
- 2. Position Cabinet unit into required position carefully. Remove Centre panel and Side panels then store them in safe location to re-attach later.




3. With reference to "MAJOLICA PORTO Installation instruction", attach the Basin bracket to the Cabinet unit.


(Do not use "5.8x63 wood screws included in the package of Majolica porto. Please use "M6 screw, nut and washer included in the package of Cabinet unit.)




4. With reference to "MAJOLICA PORTO Installation instruction", attach the thermostat, water controller, shower hose, neck base, drain housing to Majolica porto basin.




5. Lower the basin onto Cabinet unit carefully. Fit the basin into the basin bracket. Then fix it with the hooks.




6. Apply the silicon on the reverse side of Top plate as the photo below.(Silicon is not provided) Lower Top plate onto Cabinet unit carefully.




- Pipe the water supply pipe, hot water supply pipe, drain pipe with reference to "MAJOLICA PORTO Installation Instruction". Then fix the shower hose.
- Use silicon to seal around basin.(Silicon is not provided)
   Brown colour silicon is recommended for the boundary between wood surfaces and the basin.



9. Fix Handles to each drawers.



10. Re-attach Side panels and Centre panel to Cabinet unit. Unit complete.






# Do not use hot water (boiling water) of 60 °C or higher.

Hot water Using hot water of 60 °C or higher may deform or damage the parts such as the basin, shower head and water stop knob.



# Disassembly and repairs/modifications are prohibited.

Disassembly, repairs and modifications must not be conducted by people other than qualified repair technicians. Failure to follow this instruction may cause electrocution, fire or abnormal operation, leading to injury.



When adjusting the temperature of the water, reduce the volume of water, point the shower head away from the customer and check the temperature by hand. Take care when doing so, as hot water may come out of the shower head.

# Return the temperature control knob to an appropriate position after using hot water.


- •Return the temperature control knob to an appropriate position after using hot water. Continuing to use the hot water with the knob in the hot position may cause burns.
- •Using other equipment that share the same water/hot water supply source at the same time may cause unstable water temperature. If multiple equipment are to be used, move the temperature control knob slowly to adjust the water temperature.



#### Do not lean on the basin

Leaning on the basin may cause the basin to fall over.

Also, coloring dyes on the neck cushion or basin may stain the user's clothes.



### **Precautions for Use**

### **A** Caution

#### Always wipe the floor clean if it is wet.

Wipe the floor as soon as possible if it is wet after shampooing. Failure to follow this instruction may damage the floor or cause degradation and malfunctions to parts in contact with the floor. Wet floor may cause falling or water leakage to downstairs leading to an accident.



## Set the water temperature for this product to 80°C or less.

Failure to follow this instruction may cause malfunctions or damage in parts such as the stop valve, check valve, flexible pipe and thermostat water valve.

# In cold regions, ensure that water is removed.

When using this product in winter in cold regions, open the centre panel and open the check valve filter to remove water and prevent freezing. Failure to follow this instruction may cause water leakage.



#### Always use the neck cushion.

Using this product without the neck cushion may apply unnecessary load to the customer's neck, causing injury. Always use the neck cushion.



# Pay attention to the handling of the neck cushion.

Do not touch or scratch the neck cushion with a cutting tool, such as scissors, or an edged tool (including long nails). Failure to take this precaution may result in scratches or damage to the surface.

#### Do not use an abrasive compound.

Do not use an abrasive compound to clean the water faucet fixtures (showerhead, showerhead receptacle, water stop knob, and temperature control knob). Use of an abrasive compound, sponge with abrasive compound, or hard cleaning tools, such as wire wool or a nylon scrubbing brush, may damage the fixture surface.



#### Do not use peppermint or aroma oil.

Do not use peppermint or aroma oil containing menthol. Failure to take this precaution may damage the resin parts, such as the showerhead, showerhead receptacle, shower hose, water stop knob, temperature control knob, neck cushion, hair catcher, and drain cap.

# If chemicals spill on to this product, wipe them dry as soon as possible.

If chemicals such as hair dyes spill on to this product, wipe them dry as soon as possible. Failure to follow this instruction may cause discoloration, deterioration or deformation. Also, if chemicals spill on to the floor, wipe them dry as soon as possible.





# Do not cover the drain outlet when this product is not going to be used.

Do not cover the drain outlet with the drain cap, towel, or shampoo cloth after finishing the work. Water may overflow the basin when water is improperly discharged or a small amount of hot water is discharged due to an increase in water pressure during the night, resulting in water leaks.


Be sure to remove the trap cover from the drain outlet when the product is not in use.



# Do not use strongly acidic or strongly alkaline cleaning solvents.

Do not use cleaning solvents containing mainly caustic soda (NaOH) or caustic potash (KOH) to clean the drain pipe. Never pour thinners, alcohol, nail polish remover, gasoline or kerosene into the drain.

### Do not leave the shower head immersed in water.

If pressure in the water pipes decreases due to repairs that follow water stoppages, the water in the basin may flow back through the shower head.



#### Clean the hair catcher regularly.

Clean the hair catcher as regularly as possible. Continuing to use the hair catcher without cleaning it may cause the drain to become blocked with hair, leading to water overflowing and unhygienic conditions.

Try to clean the hair catcher after each shampooing.



#### Do not drop heavy objects on to the basin.

Do not place or drop heavy objects on to the basin. Failure to follow this instruction may cause damage such as scratches or cracks to the basin.




#### Pay attention to maintenance methods.

Be sure to execute daily maintenance according to the section "Maintenance" on page. In the case of insufficient or improper maintenance or when periodically replaced parts are not replaced, the customer shall be responsible for any harm, damage, or defects that result; our company shall not assume responsibility.


### **Precautions on Resin (Plated) Parts**

- Resin plating is adopted for part of the water stop knob and the temperature control knob.
- O Plating is a thin, hard metal film applied to the surface that may crack or peel due to corrosion or aged deterioration.
- O Flaws or cracks may occur on the plated surface due to impacts from falling objects.
- O Flaws or cracks may occur on the plated surface when a hard object hits the surface.
- O Peeling of the plating may occur from flaws or cracks on the plated surface.

Check to ensure that there are no flaws, cracks, or peeling of the plated surface of the knobs before using the product. If peeling is observed, immediately stop using the product and contact your closest dealer or Takara Belmont. Continued operation may result in injuries.



### **Care and Maintenance**



#### ODust the surface and remove stain.

Wipe the surface with soft and dry cloth. If the stain is hard to remove or oil is spotted, wipe with cloth soaked in dilluted neutal detergent and wringed. Then wipe it with dry cloth.

Do not use volatile chemical such as thinner, alcohol, gasoline, kerosene, or abrasive, wax, abrasive sponges and scrubbing brushes, etc.
